ATC REQUIREMENTS & FEES

MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS

ATC international membership is limited to independent training providers with a minimum of a 2-year proven track record in transnational professional training within the audiovisual industry.

Delegates to ATC meetings are heads of organisations. Decisions made through ATC members are valid unless overruled by their respective boards. The heads of organisations may appoint another delegate within their own organisation to attend meetings in their place, as and when appropriate. Other delegates may also join ATC meetings in case they have a particular mandate.

New membership must be accompanied by recommendation of at least one of the existing members.

If they wish to do so candidate members can attend an initial ATC meeting prior to making a final decision on membership and paying the annual fee.

Members wishing to resign from ATC must inform ATC of this decision in written form.

Membership fees already paid cannot be refunded.

FEE

Annual Fee: € 550 (with a 10% discount for new members in the first year).

The membership fees will be invoiced to each membership organisation at the end of March and must be paid before May 1st of that year. Failure to pay the membership fee by this date will result in loss of membership.

Heads or organisations and/or other delegates to ATC meetings will cover their own travel, subsistence and other expenses.

WORKING GROUPS OF ATC

ATC working groups of 5-6 members will be formed on an annual basis. Working groups will divide tasks and take on the responsibility for executing the yearly activity plan of ATC and all further operations as defined in the Manifesto, Definitions and Aims of ATC.
